



When Mary Magdalene arrived at Jesus' tomb on that first Easter morn, she did not carry that hope with her. She came with spices to anoint his body. She came with her fears, her grief and sadness, her dashed expectations, and maybe even her anger at God for allowing this to happen to someone that she loved. But when she finally left the tomb, she left all of those fears, questions, and feelings there in the tomb where they belong and she left with the joy of the risen Christ in her heart, and the faith and hope of a life that never dies in her soul and on her lips. What change there must have been on her face as she returned to the disciples with the Good News of Jesus' resurrection.

I too find myself overwhelmed at times with all the violence in the world; such as the shootings in our schools, the bomber in Texas, and the many world conflicts that fill the news. Then there are the natural disasters and my own personal issues; and I know that I'm not alone in those feelings. I've heard people say that we need to lay these burdens at the foot of the cross, but I think that I would like to be more like Mary Magdalene and bring them to the tomb and leave them there. For that is where they really belong. Let those things go and come away with Mary Magdalene's joy. For it was that hope and that joy that allowed May P. Butts, a young 33 year old mother, to tell her husband to wipe off his tears for she would meet him in heaven.
